



## Arthur T. Zarrow

January 8, 1926 - August 29, 2018

Arthur Zarrow, age 92, died on Wednesday, August 29, 2018 at his home in Belmont Village Senior Living in Houston, Texas.

Born and raised in Bronx, NY, Arthur was the son of Tillie and William Zarrow. He resided in Flushing, NY for much of his adult life. In 1993, he moved to Houston, Texas to enjoy the warmer climate and to live near his daughter and her family.

Upon his graduation from Evander Childs High School in 1944, he attended Fordham University in the Bronx, earning a degree in Pharmacy. Immediately after college graduation in 1948, Arthur married Jeanette Hertzberg, the love of his life.

educational programs. He loved talking to people and enjoyed spending time with family and friends.
