July 4, 1925 - June 23, 2022

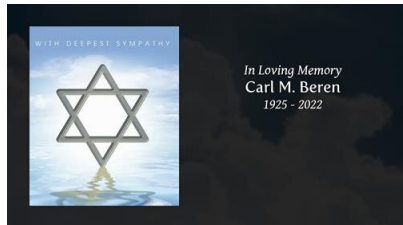
