



Howard G. Bergman

June 5, 1937 - October 29, 2022

Howard G. Bergman passed away peacefully Saturday, October 29, 2022. Son of George and Betty Bergman, Howard grew up in the Bronx, NY. He graduated from Stuyvesant High School, earned a Bachelor of Chemical Engineering degree from New York University and a Master's degree in Engineering Administration from George Washington University. As an ROTC participant, Howard entered the Army after graduation from NYU and was stationed at Fort Belvoir, VA. After completing his active duty, he remained in the US Army Reserve and retired as a full colonel. Howard was a dedicated civil servant, having worked for the Department of the Navy, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the General Services Administration. EPA lent him to the City of Cleveland to serve as its Commissioner of Air Pollution Control for four years. At GSA, he served as project manager on the construction or renovation of several federal courthouses.

Howard is survived by his wife of 59 years, Roberta Allen Bergman, four children: Elizabeth, Andrea, Michael (Karin), and Stephanie Cruz (Jorge); and five grandchildren: Zoe, Zachary and Sarah Bergman, Olivia Cruz, and Dallas Spelman.
