Mike graduated from White Station High School, Memphis, in 1963 and attended Memphis State University where he and a small group of friends initiated a chapter of ZBT Fraternity. Following graduation, he attended Illinois College of Podiatric Medicine 1963-1967. In 1971-1972 he was Board Certified by the American Board of Podiatric Surgery August 9, 1980.
