Roslyn Wechsler, 94 years old, passed away on August 3, 2024 at Village on the Parkway-Plano in Plano, Texas. She was born on November 2, 1929 in Forest Hills, New York to Samuel and Esther Zaiff.

Roslyn grew up in New York and graduated from Forest Hills High School. After high school she received her teaching certification from New York University after which she taught in the New York Public School System for several years before she relocated to Dallas, Texas after she married

Roslyn married Lawrence Wechsler on November 24, 1951.

They were happily married for 69 years when Larry passed away in October 2019.

After moving to Dallas, Roz retired from teaching and became a full-time housewife.

After her children were grown, Roslyn became accomplished in needlepoint designs and soon after purchased a needlepoint store, Needlework Finishing and Showroom on Lovers Lane in Highland Park. She taught scores of customers over a couple of decades how to needlepoint and they all appreciated her teaching and ability. She received numerous blue ribbons for

her needlepoint work from the State Fair of Texas. She would enter several pieces every year until her customers finally asked her to stop because nobody else had an opportunity to get a blue ribbon. She always took that as the highest compliment.

Roslyn is survived by her daughter, Jill Goldin (Sidney), Her son Arthur Wechsler (Anne) and five grandchildren. Sara Goldin, Holly Firestone (Eric), Joshua Wechsler, Rebecca Marx (Dustin) & Adam Wechsler (Jessica) and her Sister Gloria Abramowitz, and 4 Great Grandchildren, Max, Jack, Rori & Eve.
