



## Sidney Morgen

October 1, 1928 - September 6, 2015

Sidney Morgen born on Oct, 1, 1928 (17 Tishri 5689 - Chol Hamo'ed Sukkot) in New York, passed away Sunday, Sept. 6, 2015 (22 Elul 5775), in Houston, Sidney graduated from High School of Commerce in New York in January 1945.

He graduated with a bachelor's degree from CCNY, and a master's degree from University of Arizona in Tucson, Ariz.

He married Beverly Paula Howard on Nov. 25, 1953, in Tucson. The couple had three sons: Henry Morgen (married to Suzanne Weiss), Steven Morgen (married to Diane Dorf), and Victor Morgen (deceased).

Sidney worked for the Arizona State Employment Service for many years, and then switched careers, becoming a high school counselor at Cholla High School in the Tucson Unified School District.

He was a longtime member of Temple Emanu El in Tucson, and later joined Congregation Or Chadash. Sidney attended Sabbath services regularly and, for many years, led a Torah study group at Emanu El. He also taught in Emanu El's religious school.
